The 31<sup>st</sup> RESER Conference will take place on October 14<sup>th</sup>–15<sup>th</sup> 2021 on Bildungscampus in Heilbronn, Germany under the heading »The disruptive Role of Data, AI and Ecosystems in Services Next Gen«

The Covid-19 pandemic clearly demonstrates that future services and business models will strongly rely on direct digital interactions between service providers and customers. Thus, the service-economy »Next Gen« leads to a stronger digital integration of customers, partners, and service providers. This year's RESER-conference takes a closer look at these fundamental economic, social and technological transformation processes. Using a broad and holistic understanding of artificial intelligence, the key question is how service society and service economy changes when data and data analytics become the main drivers for service innovation and the provision of services.



To intensify the interaction between research and practice, the programme will include academic sessions as well as contributions from the field. A special highlight is a two-day makeathon, the results of which will be presented and discussed at the conference.

The Conference will be organised and held by the Research and Innovation Center for Cognitive Service Systems (KODIS) of the Fraunhofer Institute for Industrial Engineering IAO in cooperation with other research and educational institutions at the new Education Campus.
